
DIABETES & NUTRITION EDUCATION SERVICES




What does the clinic offer?

The UAB Diabetes & Nutrition Education's team of registered dietitians/certified diabetes care and education specialists provide assistance ranging from basic nutrition education to comprehensive programs that meet the needs of people with special health concerns, such as:

- Diabetes and diabetes prevention
- Chronic kidney disease
- · Hypertension/high blood pressure
- Hyperlipidemia/high cholesterol
- Gastrointestinal disorders
- Celiac disease
- Assistance with tube feeding or IV nutrition
- · Nutrition evaluations to improve health
- Nutrition evaluation to gain, lose or maintain weight

Based on your individual needs, opportunities to learn how to improve your health through lifestyle changes are offered individually and in group sessions.
