

A stroke occurs when a blood vessel is either blocked by a clot or bursts. When that happens, brain cells in the immediate area no longer receive the oxygen and nutrients they need, causing them to die.

BALANCE

Loss of balance or coordination, dizziness





Blurry, double, or loss of vision in one eye





FACE

Does one side of the face droop?





ARM

Are they unable to raise both arms & keep them there?





SPEECH

Is speech slurred or speaking difficult?
